- All set for TRAC
- TRAC DE has 25 registered, only 5 from the Chicago Region. Many are coming with Club Racers for car transport.
- Kurt Konrath inquired as the to schedule for DE.
 - Fri 5 sessions; Sat 4 sessions; Sun 3 sessions; single run group for all sessions
- Discussion had about DE events being down nationwide. Some conjecture that vehicles are getting more expensive, regular attendees are getting older and younger people have less interest. Some Regions are doing away with DE and just hosting Club Race(s), replacing volunteers with paid workers

- Half price event worked well, attendance was full at 122 participants. Projecting to make more money than last year.
- Weather at event was excellent
- Shirts were donated by the Exchange
- Next event is before a SCCA event so we are seeing some SCCA participants registering to get more practice

- Even though the run groups were large there were no issues

- The question about replacing the loaner helmets was raised again. Noted that some tracks have rentals available. Also concerned with loaners for Autocross.

usually only a single dealer in the region and no competition. The Chicago Region has a
number of very strong dealerships so significant involvement t doesn't make business sense
due to the competition

Concours Report: (Henrique Regina, Alex Block)

- The Bolingbrook event went very well. 23 cars judged, 4 in corral with many more in the parking lot. Good attendance.
- Comments made about some of the excellent cars such as the green GT2 RS and the Red Macan which both placed 1st in class
- Trend for Concours is positive
- Noted that pre-registration is not mandatory except for the Farnsworth House event which already has a number of registrants
- Purchased the rest of the prizes/giveaways for the season

Rallye Report: (Anna & Andy Skura)

- Rallye #2 is in the books. Had 28 cars start with 25 finishing. This was a very large attendance for a rallye.
- There were 5 novices. Touring instructions were given to teams which had not attended the school.
- At the end of the Rallye it was discovered that one of the teams had a minor child without the proper waiver. Stressed the need for more diligence.
- There were 2 teams with 3 adults in the vehicle. Since these teams used the touring instructions and were not eligible for awards this was deemed okay especially as they apparently enjoyed the experience
- Rallve #3 is readv.
- Rallye #4 is still under construction.
- Invoice for the etched glasses totaled \$900. Because of an error by the supplier there are a number of surplass glasses with a slight defect. Discussion was had about auctioning these off for the charity at future events
- There was discussion about the Rallye App being developed. At this time an Android device is required to set up the rallye route but either iPhone or Android can be used to run the participant app. Several non-rallye members are very interested in this.

- Potters Picnic and Concours:
