The Scene Report: (Neil MacDonald) The Scene Report: (Neil MacDonald)

- The first reformatted issue of *The Chicago Scene* was published in July 2018, at 36 pages per issue (18 editorial, 18 advertising). The most recent issue of *The Chicago Scene* will be published in November 2019; it's the 8th issue in the new format. Here's how it currently breaks down for cost per page:
 - 48 pages per issue, of which 24 pages are advertising, and 24 pages are editorial
 - the press run is 2545 copies per issue
 - the approximate cost per issue, all up for layout, printing and postage is \$10,958 (\$65,748 per year for 6 issues)

• the approximate cost per page, per issue, for layout, printing, and postage is \$229 per page (rounded up to \$230 per page)

Here is the current breakdown of what the Club is charging *Scene* advertisers to lay out, print, and deliver their advertisement to our membership:

- a full-page ad: \$175/issue if 4x placements are purchased and paid for up front. The Club's members subsidize each full page advertiser \$55 per issue.
- a half-page ad: \$105/issue if 4x placements are purchased and paid for up front. The Club's members subsidize each half-page advertiser \$10 per issue.
- Premium pages (cover pages) . (currently a full-page ad cost x 1.4) = \$240 ea. for 4 issues if 4x placements are purchased and paid for up front. The Club "makes" \$10 per page for the cover pages (inside front, and inside/outside back of magazine).

Here is a proposal to increase the cost of advertising in *The Scene* to the following rates per issue:

- increase from \$175 per page to \$230 per page for a standard full page placement if 6x placements (full calendar year) are purchased and paid for up front, for a total of \$1380/yr. This covers the Club's actual cost of layout, printing, and delivery per advertising page.
- increase from \$105 per page to \$115 per page for a half -page ad if 6x placements are purchased and paid for up front, for a total of \$690/yr.
- increase from \$240 to \$290/pg. for a premium full page placement if 6x placements are purchased and paid for up front, for a total of \$1740/yr.
