Announcing T.R.A.C. 2000 ...

The Road America Challenge), the Chicago Region's Drivers' Education and eighth annual PCA Club Race event to be held over the Labor Day weekend.

This year marks the 50th anniversary of racing at Elkhart Lake's Road America and we hope you can join us in September for what always proves to be a fun and memorable event. At four miles in length, Road America is the longest road course in North America. It contains fourteen turns and three long straights through the Kettle Moraine section of central Wisconsin making it one of the most scenic, challenging and exciting tracks in the world.

This will be our second event at Road America in 2000 with a brand new format. Instead of three days, the event will now take place over the course of four days and feature two separate driving events in order to accommodate more participants. The Club Race portion of the weekend will be held on Friday, September 1st and Saturday, September 2nd followed by the Drivers' Education portion on Sunday, September 3rd and Monday, September 4th. This new format will allow us to accommodate up to 480 total participants.

For our Chicago Region PCA Club Racing license holders, the registration information for the **T.R.A.C.** 2000 Club Race will be mailed to you in mid-June and your forms can then be returned to the event registrar with a postmark date NO SOONER than July 12th. Club Race forms received with a postmark prior to July 12th WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED in order to give all Club Racers the opportunity to participate.

Due to the popularity of the event, we strongly recommend that anyone wishing to participate in the Drivers' Education portion of the weekend register early. The registrar will be accepting registration forms from Drivers Education participants exclusively through July 12th. After that date, Drivers' Education registration will open up to any Club Racers who wish to enjoy a longer weekend at Road America following the conclusion of their event of Saturday, September 2nd.

The Drivers' Education event will be divided into four run groups with a maximum of 60 cars per run group. Please note that we will be offering enrollment for up to 25 Novice drivers this year, however all drivers must have some prior track driving experience to qualify for this event.

All cars participating in this event (Club Race and Drivers Education) must not exceed the Road America noise restriction of 108 dB. Please ensure that your car is in compliance with this limit as there are residential areas near the track and Road America personnel will be monitoring our cars throughout the weekend.

Registration confirmation packets will include a copy of the *Rules of Road America*. Please take the time to read them before the start of the weekend to ensure that you the driver, your family, crew, and friends will comply with these rules. These rules are the landlords, not ours. So, please help us comply.

We encourage drivers' education participants to arrive Saturday morning to register and have their cars teched before lunch. By doing this, you will be able to enjoy the four featured PCA Club Races on Saturday afternoon, the post-race festivities at the track, and then display your car at the T.R.A.C. 2000 Concours to be held streetside at Siebkens on Saturday evening.

At 4:00 pm, the streets surrounding Siebkens will be closed off for what is always a great Concours and beginning of the best Party of the season. In addition to the regular five Concours classes, there will be a special Concours class for race cars. The race cars will arrive at Siebkens in parade with a police escort at approximately 6:00 pm and return to the track in a parade with police escort promptly at 9:00 pm. All participating drivers and volunteer workers will have the Concours Registration Fee waived.

All drivers, family, crew, and friends are encouraged to join us at Siebkens for the **T.R.A.C.** 2000 Dinner and Party complete with a live entertainment to get everyone in the mood. All registered drivers and volunteers will be the dinner guests of the Chicago Region.

There will be 24-hour security at the track on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights. This means those moonlight mechanics can do their final adjustments. As a reminder, the track gates will close promptly at 7:00 pm on Monday evening. With the 24-hour security, Road America will permit participants to camp on the grounds for a fee. Road America also requires a fee for electrical hookups. Also new this year is the availability of rental golf carts at the track for the weekend.

We think you will find this Road America event to be the best track event of the year so please remember to register early to reserve your spot.


