#### **KARTING FOR A CAUSE**

We will be running a Karting Enduro race series to raise money for the Big Brothers, Big Sisters organization of Metropolitan Chicago. This organization links volunteers with underprivileged children in single parent families, providing them with role models and parental support.

#### THE EVENT:

The Event will consist of four - 1-hour races that will be electronically timed and scored. The electronic scoreboard displays in real time the following data by kart team: number of laps completed, place ranking, last lap time, and fastest lap time. Mandatory pit stops will be required to bring both driving skills (saving the brakes or the tires); strategy and pit driver changes into the skill required to win. There is a maximum of 10 Karts allowed on the track therefore requesting teams be formed with 4 drivers. The event is open on a first come first serve basis, so form your teams now.

#### PLEDGES / SPONSOSHIP FOR CHARITY:

Each driver will be requested to get 5 sponsors on a \$ per lap for charity, much like pledges in a walk-a-thon. You can form a team your-self and send in the application as a group or you can send in a single entry and ask to be teamed up with other single drivers. Your sponsorship / pledge goal as a driver in the event is \$125 for all 4 races, or about \$25 per sponsor (see sponsorship form for details).

#### **HOW TO REGISTRER:**

We will require your initial commitment for the event in the form of the "Entry Registration" (below) and entry fee to secure a Kart for you and / or your team. We will then ask that you get pledges with using the sponsorship / pledge form. This sponsorship form is required to be filled out prior to the event and brought to the actual event.

### LEARNING TO DRIVE A STICK THE PCA WAY

For someone who has never driven a stick, there were always excuses for not wanting to learn. My

biggest paranoia is being stuck on a hill with someone inches behind me. The other one is stopping at a light or 4 way intersection, shifting from neutral to first, stepping on the gas just the right time when you've started to let out the clutch, but then the car stalls in the middle of the intersection!

Fortunately, I've had a lot of opportunities to finally learn how to drive a manual transmis-

sion the fun way through the many events held by the PCA Chicago Region. For starters, my husband and driving instructor, Kevin Schilling, has a lot of patience and understanding- attributes he's acquired from being a driving instructor at Blackhawk and Road America. In late June, the PCA held a Club Racina event at Gingerman in South Haven, Michigan. Since Kevin has decided to turn his 9305 into a full Club Racer.

we had no option but to buy a street car, so we purchased a Fly Yellow 993 cab on Saturday morning and drove out to watch the race. On Sunday morning we caught up with the Chicago region racers and spent a few minutes saying hi. Kevin introduced the new car as "Anna's", to which Chris Inglot replied to him, "If ing Kevin lay out rallye III, "Take it's Anna's, why are you driving?" "She has never driven a manual" he replied. How convenient.... the track was now open for touring. I learned for the first time how to drive a manual at speeds of no more than 40mph with no oncoming traffic or cars passing and distracting me. There must have been no more than 5 cars on the track. It was also very conducive to learning because there

were no trees or barriers in close proximity to the track which means if you went off track you'd end up on flat grass covered ground.

The next event was the Autocross III on Sunday, July 16 near Lake Geneva, Wisconsin. Even though my best time was 1 minute 40 seconds to make it through a sea of

cones on the paved lot, while everybody else was doing the course in under a minute, I had a blast! The men who make up the majority of the PCA drivers were very supportive and encouraging.

The most fun I had was helpthe Long Way Home." During the final pre-run, I drove while he navigated. The roads through the country were breathtaking and few were winding through cornfields with a CAST of at least 50. Unlike the racetracks, there were plenty of stops on hills with cars stopped behind you. Oh no, my biggest fear! One good piece of advice is to remember to put your emergency

> brake on lightly if you start to roll back, the car will easily go forward, but not back (just remember to release it once you start moving). An alternative plan of action is to do what Peggy Gallagher did the first time she started learning to drive a stick. Put the emergency brake on and get out of the car and pretend you are having car trouble so

the cars behind you go around you, then proceed after all the "witnesses" are gone.

Reasons to learn how to drive a stick: Feel more in control of the car's power; it definitely is a lot more fun to drive than an automatic; and men really appreciate it when their wives at least try.

Takes about 2 hours per vehicle depending on complexity and number of "panels". In my opinion (from terrible experience), this is not a task for a DIYer---the

competence of the installer really is the key. Try www.xpel.com for info. I'm not related to Mr. Stagohr nor do I have any business interest with his company-just a satisfied client.

In my humble opinion, this is the way to go unless you're going to seriously concour your vehicle by national standards which would probably require removal of the product prior to judging/evaluation. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.

Hopefully the below message will raise a few thoughts for all of you! I thought I would share this with you as I have unfortunately experience this "effect" and so find this story very interesting & the inherent dangers food for thought. Please note that this comes from friends in DuPont and is another example of their safety commitment & culture.

Subject: Air Bag Safety Reminder

This was recently shared at Victoria and a good reminder to review with family what happens when an air bag deploys.

Recently, my wife and daughter were involved in an automobile accident during which the airbags in our vehicle deployed. The airbags functioned properly (in conjunction with the seat belts) and fortunately neither my wife nor daughter were seriously injured...another reminder that seat belts work also.

The reason for the note is that while the airbags worked properly they also created a condition of significant concern because we had not fully discussed what would occur if the airbags ever deployed. We had discussed things like 'do not sit on the edge of the seat or lean over the dashboard when the vehicle is use', 'sit up straight and well back in the seat', 'always use your seat belt', etc. What we had not discussed was the fact that when airbags inflate/deflate they release smoke along with nitrogen gas which creates a dense fog in the vehicle. An offensive odor was also evident. The end result was that my daughter panicked (thinking the vehicle was on fire), quickly removed her seat belt, and bolted from the car into the adjoining traffic lane. Fortunately, no cars were passing by at the time. My wife also quickly exited the car suspecting it might be on fire. We have since heard of several people being trapped in their cars after the airbags have deployed. Some indicated being almost hysteric because they didn't understand what was occurring.

I pass on this information in the event anyone else has discussed 'most' of what to expect and think about regarding airbags, but may have missed the same point we did. ZERO is the goal on and off the plant.




