





# Take the Long Way Home Rallye - A First Timer's Experience

We are new to the Porsche club. We had a never participated in a rallye nor a club outing. When we saw the advertisement for the Take the Long Way Home Rallye in the Chicago Scene, we decided it would be a great first event. So, we registered, indicating on the form that we were rookies.

A few days later, Kevin called to talk things over. He advised us to do the rallye in the Touring class where we would be given the turns and only had to concentrate on hitting the checkpoints at the right times; that is, executing the course at the right speeds. The tougher way, for the experienced teams, was Seat of the Pants (SOP) where the teams would be given clues to identify the course as well as the speeds. Kevin advised us to do the rallye for fun and not take it too seriously. He hinted strongly that we would not do too well if we tried SOP. We took his advice.

The day before the rallye, we spent a few hours polishing up our black 1992 911. It had to look sharp. We wanted to make our debut into the Porsche club with a car that looked great. And it did - until we left home on Sunday morning for the 5-mile drive to the rallye starting point in Batavia. It rained! By the time we arrived, the car was pretty dirty. So much for our initial image. Now, we just hoped that we would execute the rallye without embarrassing ourselves.

As we checked in, Anna told us that we were to be the first car to leave. She told us that we would receive detailed instructions 10 minutes before our schedule departure time. And she handed us a big #1 for our car and a set of general instructions about 4 pages long. We huddled around cups of cappuccino with another rookie team and lamented there way no way we would ever understand what to do. And worse, we had to do it first! But, after a few times reading

A few days later, Kevin called to through the instructions, things didn't as over. He advised us to do the look so bad.

While waiting to start, we met a number of other teams who were experienced in rallyes. They were great confidence builders for us. Everyone was friendly and helpful. We got a lot of great advice. Now, we felt a lot more confident. The participants were taking the rallye seriously, but not too competitively. Everyone was looking to do well, but everyone wanted to have a good time, putting us much more at ease.

We pulled our #1 car into the starting position, and a #2 Boxster pulled in right behind us. The cars were to leave at 1-minute intervals. At the appointed time, precisely 11:01, we started our engine and pulled away and quickly realized we had made our first mistake. We had not synchronized our clock to the official rallye clock. So, we might have a built in error from the start. But, not to worry, as we felt our clock was not too far off. So we proceeded.

The first part was really easy. Our Touring class instructions were clear and we just drove the course controlling our speed. Since cars were to leave every minute, we knew that the Boxster should be about one minute back. We never saw it in our mirrors so at least we were not going too slowly. The course took us through the back roads of Kane County. Although there was some residential driving, the majority was open highway through the cornfields. We broke the speed instructions a few times on those curvy country roads by executing a few high-speed tests to make sure our car was performing in top condition. The penalty points were worth it. Things were looking good at the halfway point, and the weather turned to bright sun-

We learned that Kevin's advice to drive in the Touring class had been right on the money for us. The SOP instructions were challenging. We had expected that they would be mathematical

such as an instruction to drive at a particular speed for a given time interval with calculations necessary to navigate. Instead they were based on logic with multiple levels of rules and a precedence order. The trick was to apply the rules correctly and quickly each time a decision situation was encountered. It was not always obvious which way to turn at some Y's and T's. We turned incorrectly a couple of times even with the Touring instructions. But Kevin and Anna had planned for the contingency that people might get lost and gave each car an emergency envelope with a map showing how to reach the next check point (with a penalty, of course). Luckily, we did not have to use ours. Also, the course was laid out so that some common errors would still bring the car to a checkpoint, but from the wrong direction with another penalty.

The rallye finished at Kevin and Anna's beautiful house in rural Batavia. Most, but not all, of the participants finished. Only a few teams were lost or gave up early. By now, the sun was shining brightly. About 25 Porsches parked on their driveway and lawn. Everyone completed their paper work (except us since we didn't realize we were supposed to hand it in for official scoring) and enjoyed the cars, camaraderie, and cooled off with refreshments. Most of the teams went to dinner together at a local restaurant. The cars lined up and proceeded in parade fashion through the countryside from Kevin and Anna's to the restaurant. A Batavia police escort blocked off intersections along the way so we could pass through as a group. We got a lot of stares including the policeman who had a grin from ear to ear. Finally, we assembled in an area in downtown Batavia and everyone ate. It was a beautiful sight to see so many Porsches together in such a pretty setting.

That evening, at home, we decided we would do it again. We would prepare by going over this rallye's instructions again so that we would be more familiar with what to expect the next time. The only other lesson was

that the driver (Chuck) should learn to listen to the navigator (Judy) and not question instructions. This will be harder to learn.

It was a great day and a lot of fun. We will do it again!
