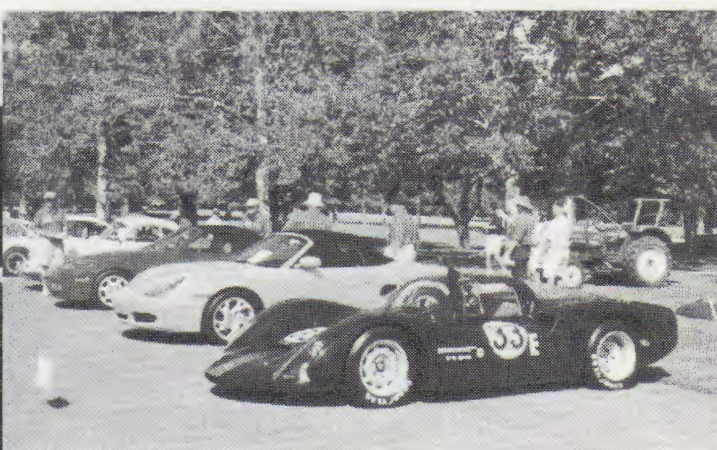

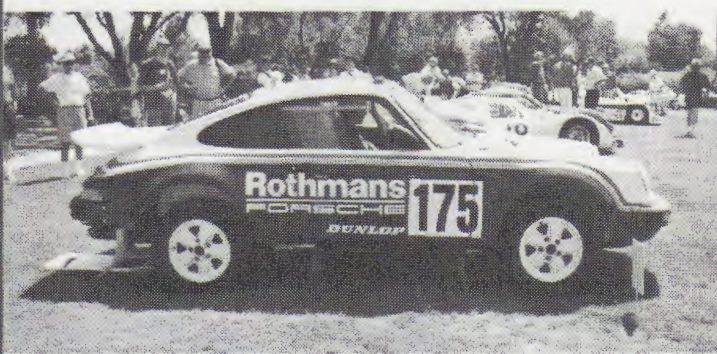

# CONCOUR GROWTH IN CHICAGO

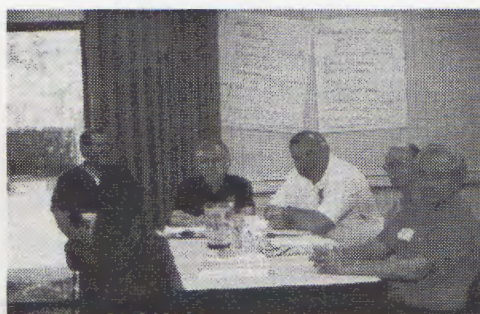

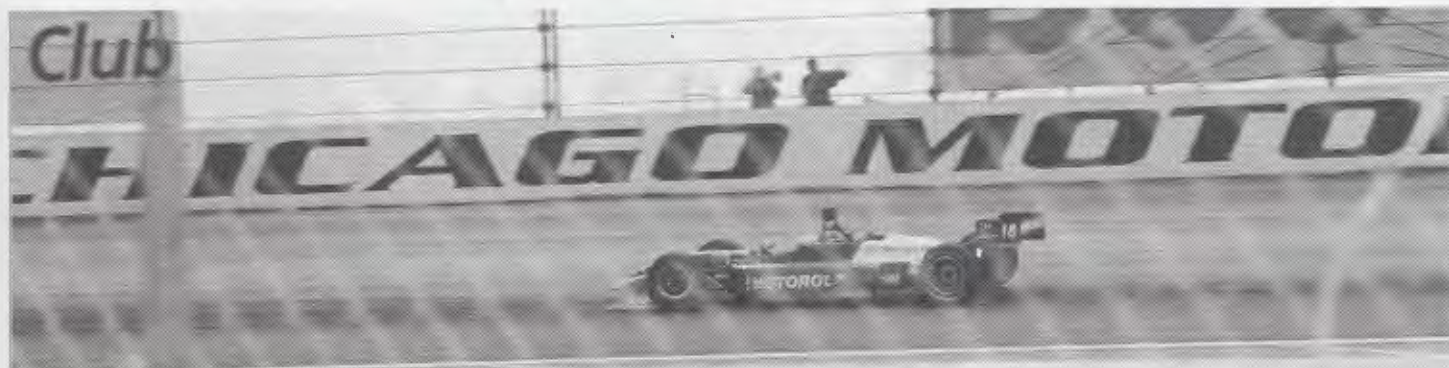
