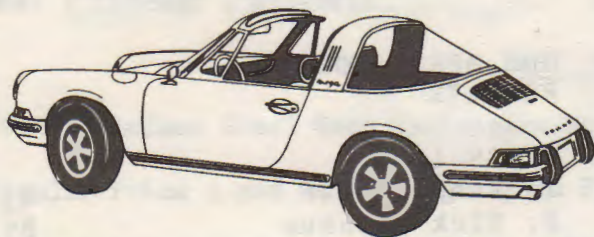

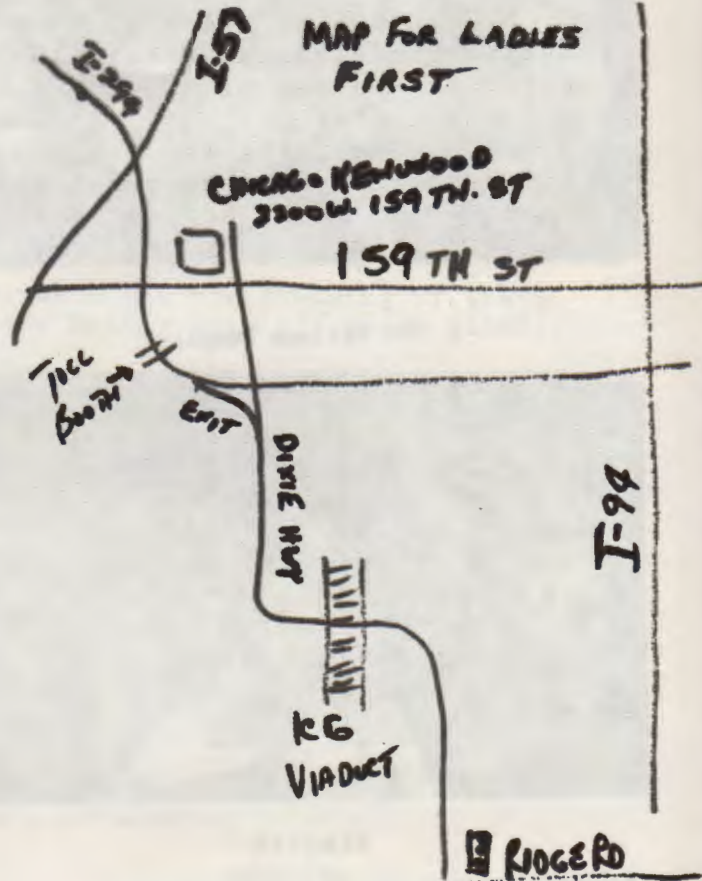
We're expecting a beautiful, clear night and lots of fun.

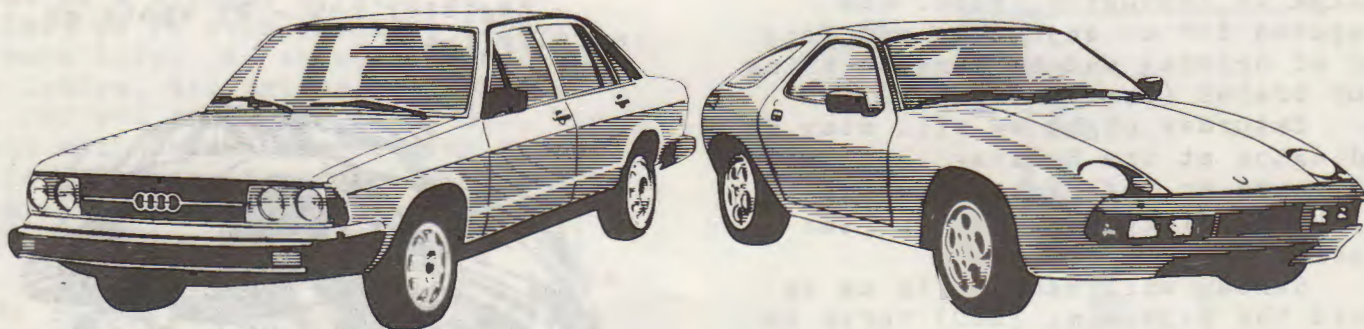

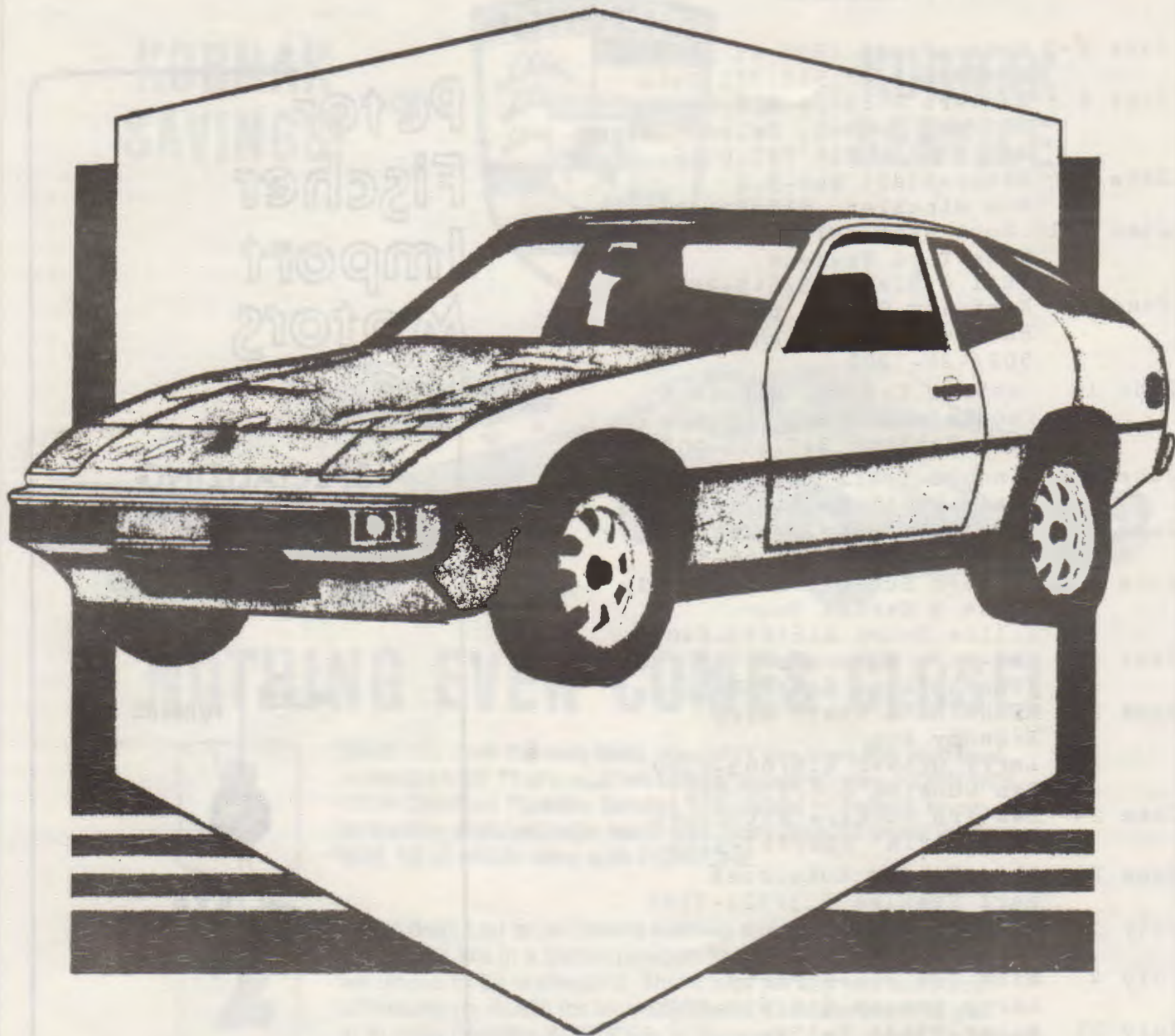

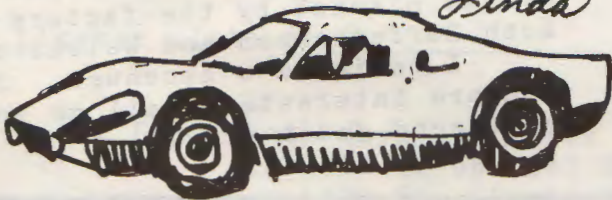


## LINDATORIAL
