

An experienced instructor guided everyone step-bystep through the process of mixing three different shades for each color, teaching participants how to add depth





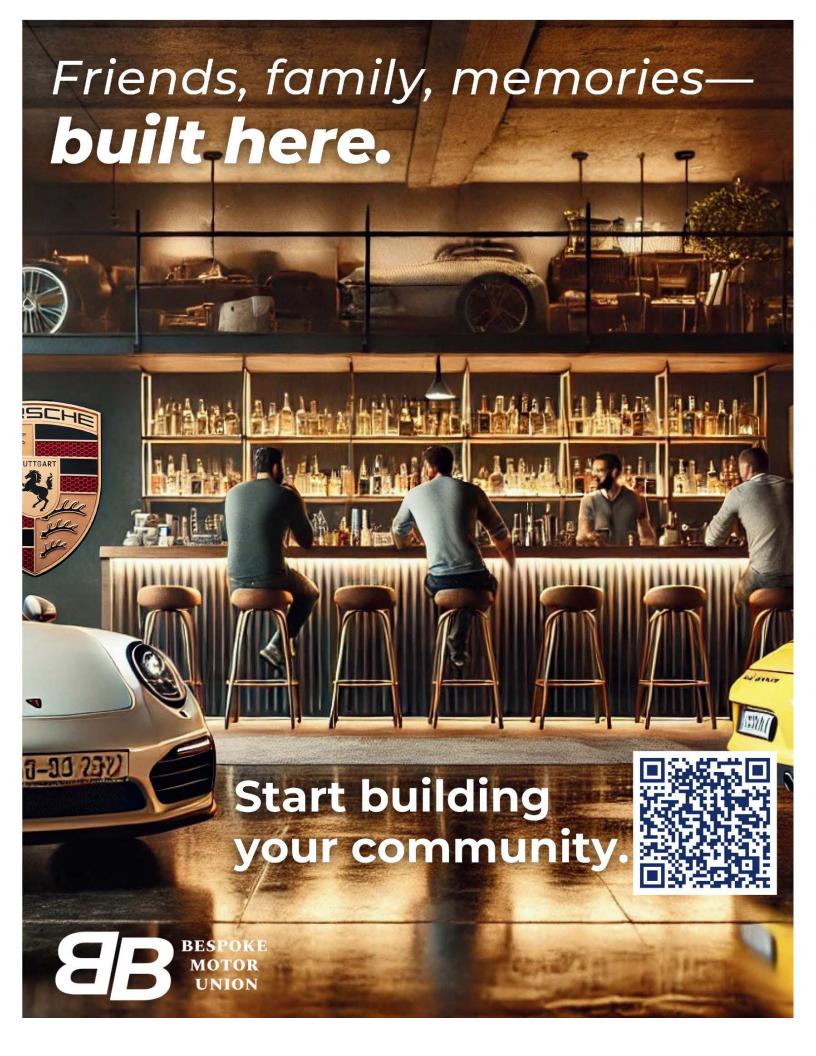
It has been a few years since the event offered a night race and this year it returned to the schedule to the pleasure of many. Our weekend began with test and turn on Thursday giving drivers a chance to get back in the saddle. On Friday it was much of the same testing and getting heads back into racing. The only exception was running the track at dusk, which is not common during most events. This gave those running the night race a chance to get acclimated to night driving at speed. I was anxious for the night

race as it offers new experiences. Note, if your idea of having fun is 160 mph with bright lights in your mirrors and a limited view in front of you I suggest you give it a try next year.

up and running for the second sprint race. The fuel cell fixed, the radiator fixed, the driver questionable, but ready to go. The planets were aligned for the green flag on the second sprint race. The competition was strong with some close racing finally... then my weekend ended as a fellow driver attempting to fit his car in a place it didn't fit ended the race for me. Reflecting back on it, my weekend ended as it started, being towed back to Eurosport, only this time with damage beyond repair at a track. Disappointing, yes, I was more disappointed for the early flight back to the cold of Chicago. Again, without the endless efforts from the team of mechanics at Eurosport my fun in the Florida sun would be less, thank you guys!

As my old friend Dan Gallagher would say "fun was had by all". ■

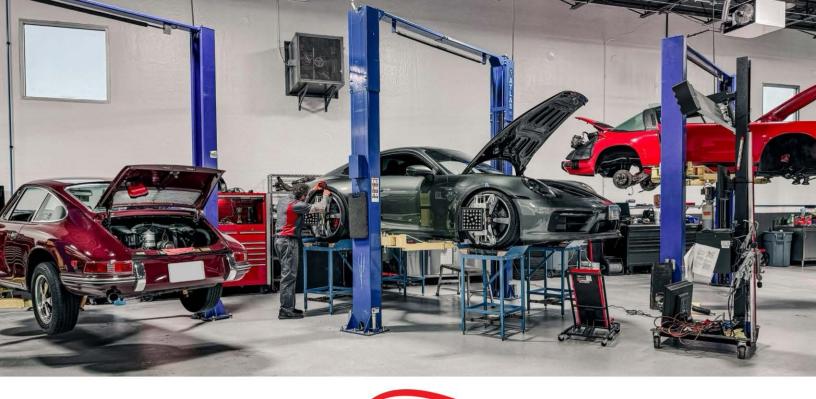

The Concours Lawn: An Interview with Jim Kutill

When your Porsche ownership started in the 70's and your PCA membership began in 1981 – as it does for Jim & Laura Kutill – your experience and knowledge are a treasure trove of insight, wisdom and inspiration for everyone on the Concours lawn. From his first PCA event (at Soldier Field) to current day competition, Jim's welcoming smile, heart-felt laugh and complimentary judging demeanor are only rivaled by his beautiful 914.

From an ego-deflating last place finish in his first event – Potter's Picnic, 1985 – Jim's yellow rays of sunshine rose to the top of the Chicago Region class THREE times. Adding luster to the shine, TWO top finishes, at Parade in 2013 & 2015, make this mid-engine a radiating sunburst! Sitting with the judges at dinner in 2015 made the trip to French Lick truly unforgettable.





Resprayed in 1983(!) and looking glorious today is four-wheeled evidence this 914 is loved and well-manicured by two generations of Kutills. For those of us without Parade trophies, their prep work and cleaning guidance are needed lessons to apply (with a soft cloth of course). A "serious detail at the start of every season" puts the towels and products in motion. A regimen of claying, waxing and 303 treatments are accompanied by removing the fuel injection air flow box to better expose the engine for Concours-level cleaning. The seats are also removed for complete interior detailing (if you haven't seen the new special order seats you'll jump when viewing the tremendous interior!). Jim's Christmas & birthday gifts from Griot's are applied as liberally as advice he's continually honing from our local experts – Pat Yanahan, Ron Bean & Steve Koch.

Self-admitted, "I'm not a very technical person." So, Jim

found his niche in Concours. He's "... enjoyed learning more about the car and being proud of how it looks. But the best part has been the people I've been involved with over the years." His keenly-focused judge's eyes don't miss a piece of lint nor a dirty wiper blade, but his mantra is to "...almost always compliment the owner on the car" and offers follow-up tips to participants. Want to know what Jim sees most entrants miss? "Seat seams almost always show lint and dirt....on a 911, the center of the pulley almost always has little



pieces of the belt. But there is one thing that seems to be universal: I think every hood or engine lid underside has holes in it. It's a rare car that doesn't have dirt inside those holes."

We all love our Porsches and Jim perspective is a shining example of The Concours Lawn - "I participate in Concours for a couple of reasons. First, I really enjoy the camaraderie of the other Concours crazies. Second, I am proud of how it (his 914) looks after all these years. And, it's become a family event. Being out in the alley with my two sons is fun." The Kutills, their smiles, and their AMAZING 914 are reasons why our Lawn is a treasured soil.


