Treasurer's Report (Catherine Fischer)

The club's financial summary starts with total assets in February, 2024 of \$661,000 compared to February 2025, of \$760,000 with a YoY of \$98,000. Our total cash assets in February 2024 were \$516,000 and February 2025 were \$482,000 leaving a YoY change of -\$33,000. Income for February was \$11,000 with a YTD of \$26,900. Our expenses were \$10,000 and YTD of -42,000. Top monthly payments were Blackhawk Farms for \$48,800, covering the track rental for the full year. Adding the two chili cook offs of \$1,000 and \$2,000 gives a total of \$52,100. Total bank account balances, including checking, savings and CDs Toal \$456,000 as opposed to 2024 of \$495,916.

Charity money collected in Feb. was \$1,400 and YTD is \$3,900. Accounts receivable totaled \$18,500.
