The club's financial summary starts with total assets in April 2025 of \$795,000, compared to April 2024 of \$775,726. Cash assets in April 2025 were \$451,453 compared to April 2024 of \$487,096. Income for April was \$50,045 with a YTD of \$94,735. Our expenses were -\$36,751 and YTD of -\$95,731.

Top income sources were Events, PCA Rebate.

Top monthly payments were Scene, Dinner Dance deposit, RADE and SparkShop.

Total bank account balances, including checking, savings and CDs Toal \$451,453 as opposed to 2024 of \$487,096.

Charity collections are good with YTD at \$9,342 versus last year of \$7,258

Tax return is in process. Expect bill to be \$3650. Motion to accept the charge up to \$4,000.
