We held our 2nd event on 6/14 with 59 timed entries and 8 no-shows. It was a great event with competitors getting 11 runs in during the day.

Looking ahead to the 9/13/25 AX5 event that coincides with PCA's 70th anniversary, I'm thinking of ways to make the event unique and have explored the following:

- 1) Having the team from MPC fire up the grill for attendees with hot dogs/brats/burgers estimate of costs tbd.
- 2) Have a one-off competitive event for those that have top time in each of their respective classes where the highest and lowest times of that competitor's class are averaged, and the competitor will have 1 attempt to get as close to that average time as possible. (i.e. top time for B1 is 35 seconds, but the average time is 40 second. They will have to try to get as close to 40 seconds on a single attempt as possible). The top three competitors with the closest times to their class average would each receive a \$50 voucher good towards any future event within 1 year (\$150 total). Dana, please let me know if you see any issues here.
- 3) I considered having Sim Drive Chicago bring their trailer with 3 sim rigs out for the day, however their quoted price is \$4000 and that would wipe out most (if not all) of the AX program's budgeted profit for the year. I don't see this as a feasible option given the cost, but I wanted to make note of it to see if any board members felt I should be doing more for the 9/13 event than what I'm planning on with items 1 & 2.
