Secretary's Report (Mark Prescott)

Treasurer's Report (Catherine Fischer)

The financial report was distributed prior to the meeting and reviewed. The club's financial summary starts with total assets in July 2025 of \$755,706 compared to July 2024 of \$802,458. Cash assets in July 2025 were \$470,056 compared to July 2024 of \$510,953. Income for July was \$77,997 with a YTD of \$348,458, mostly due to TRAC. Our expenses were -\$74,116 and YTD of -\$319,943.

Top income sources were Events, PCA Rebate.

Top monthly payments were TRAC final deposit, Scene.

Total bank account balances, including checking, savings and CDs Toal \$470,046 as opposed to 2024 of \$511,000.

Charity collected YTD is \$16,124 versus \$16,912 last year.

Top receivables are Napleton (Dana working with them to resolve).

Net income YTD is \$15,617.89 versus last year at \$-19,430.93 for a difference of +\$35,048 due to RADE clearing costs this year.

Events were reviewed by each, most everything did well.

Our bank account had a couple of fraudulent charges. Steps are being taken with Chase to correct the charges and will work moving forward to prevent this.

Taco Tuesday in July went well thanks to Pete. Event had about 45 drivers and good weather. Good event. Thanks to all who helped. No incidents but two mechanical breakdowns.

Gingerman Report (Glenn DeWeirdt)

Via email - We currently have 78 registrants and 74 cars including four administrative attendees. I expect 6-8 additional registrants for the event. This is well below the typical attendance of 100+ cars. The most notable trend is the very low numbers of Novice registrants. This is typically our largest group with 25-30 registrants, we currently have 13. I am expecting total expenses to be around \$25,000 and we currently have receipts of \$26,600 so the event should show a profit but significantly less than in prior years.

We had to cancel the Italian Dinner at the Track this year due to the previous caterer backing out and the new caterer requiring a minimum of 80 plates at a higher per plate cost coupled with the low registration numbers. We have refunded all registrants who paid for the Italian Dinner option. We have made arrangements for pizza, beer, wine, and soft drinks for Saturday night with the cost being included in registration fee. We estimate around \$1000 for this and the cost is included in the expense estimate.

The weather is looking perfect so hopefully we will have a few extra registrants.
